## Chapter 12.08

## **Regulating The Parking Of Trailers On City Streets**

- **Section 1. Time.** No person shall park any trailer upon any public street within the City of Howard Lake, Minnesota, for a longer consecutive period than twenty-four hours.
- **Section 2. Definitions.** For the purposes of this Ordinance the term or word trailer shall include, but not be limited to, flat-bed trailers, boat trailers, closed-up and covered trailers, and general utility trailers.
- **Section 3. Towing.** The Howard Lake Police Department is authorized to tow and store any trailer parked in violation of this Ordinance. The owner may reclaim the trailer after showing proof of ownership and paying all towing and storage charges.
- **Section 4. Penalty.** Any owner or operator convicted of violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
